A.I.R. Gallery is pleased to present an exhibition of new work by Barbara Grinell. Her show, *New Paintings*, will be on view from October 4 - 28, 2012. The opening reception will be held on Thursday, October 4th, from 6 - 9pm.

Barbara Grinell's paintings speak of moonlight and storms, showing mountain peaks and winter mists. Her work reflects the feeling of solitude and the power of the natural world around us. In her time as an artist, Grinell has seen how change, uncertainty, and loss can govern life. Looking at her own experiences in upstate New York, Grinell shared, "living in the Catskills has been both an adventure and a sanctuary." Grinell has observed that her paintings, "seem to reflect the mountains where I live." Beyond these truths, Grinell wishes to let her art express itself to her audience and she invites her viewers to take what they will from her work.



Throughout her career, Grinell has shown in galleries across the United States from New York to Oregon. She has been the recipient of the Haystack Teaching Assistant Fellowship in Printmaking and a Fulbright Fellowship as an Artist-at-Large in Seoul, Korea.
