Wish You Were Here 5 will show in conjunction with *Domestic Goods*, July 28 – July 29, a group show curated by Ágnes Berecz featuring women artists from Central Europe. *Domestic Goods* includes work by Mária Berhidi, Róza El-Hassan, Ágnes Eperjesi, Ilona Keserü Ilona, Hilda Kozári, Ilona Lovas, Ilona Németh, Ágnes Eszter Szabó, Zsuzsa Szenes, Mónika Sziládi.
